***\*It is highly recommended that all students follow the dress code starting August 15, 2016. All students will be required to dress in accordance with the Modified Dress Code by October 18.***

<p><b>Shirts</b></p>	<p><i>The following shirts are permitted:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ridgewood crew neck t-shirt (not modified, tied up, torn, or altered in any way)</li> <li>• Solid color crew neck shirt (brand logos should be no larger than a quarter)</li> <li>• Solid color crew neck women’s cut shirt (brand logos should be no larger than a quarter)</li> <li>• Solid color or striped polo shirt (brand logos should be no larger than a quarter)</li> <li>• Ridgewood polo shirt</li> <li>• Solid color, striped button or plaid down shirt with a collar</li> </ul> <p>Sheer tops, mesh tops, and tank tops are not permitted</p>
<p><b>Shorts</b></p>	<p><i>The following shorts are permitted:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shorts must be secured at the waist</li> <li>• Shorts that are knee length (top of the knee) with no holes, tears, or frays</li> <li>• Shorts that are khaki color, blue, black, grey, white, or jean with a hem</li> <li>• Athletic style shorts are not permitted</li> </ul>
<p><b>Pants/ Capris</b></p>	<p><i>The following pants and capris are permitted:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pants and capris must be secured at the waist</li> <li>• Jeans that are khaki color, blue, black, white or grey with no holes, tears, or frays</li> <li>• Pants that are khaki color, blue, black, white or grey with no holes, tears, or frays</li> <li>• Capris that are khaki color, blue, black, white or grey with no holes, tears, or frays</li> </ul> <p>Spandex, leggings, jeggings, sweats, athletic style, overalls/coveralls are not permitted</p>
<p><b>Dresses &amp; Skirts</b></p>	<p><i>The following dresses are permitted:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Knee length (top of the knee) crew neck solid color or striped dresses with sleeves</li> <li>• Solid colored knee length (top of the knee) skirts that are khaki color, blue, black, or grey</li> </ul>
<p><b>Jackets &amp; Outerwear</b></p>	<p><i>The following jackets and outerwear are permitted:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ridgewood and solid colored hoodies only (hoods cannot be on heads during school day)</li> <li>• Solid color sweatshirts</li> <li>• Solid colored, striped, or flannel sweater/jacket</li> <li>• Jackets and button-down shirts that are unzipped/unbuttoned are acceptable as outerwear</li> </ul>
<p><b>Accessories &amp; Footwear</b></p>	<p><i>The following accessories and footwear are permitted:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ties, bows, belts, scarves or jewelry may be of any color or design as long as it is not disruptive to the learning environment.</li> </ul> <p>Hats, caps, bandanas, or any non-approved head covering are not permitted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoes, sandals, and boots are acceptable in any color or style.</li> </ul> <p>Bedroom or house slippers are not permitted.</p>

**Exceptions**

JROTC and Medical Academy scrubs on designated days. On designated days, whole group participation is expected.
