Student Educational Goal Pathways Explanation *Traditional: After high school, this student will enter the work force, join the military, or attend a technical or community college.

*College Prep: After high school, this student will attend a community college or four-year university (with foreign language requirement completed). *Advanced College Prep: After high school, this student will attend a more competitive four-year university (with the foreign language requirement completed).

A separate Expectations Agreement is required for all Advanced Placement courses. Schedule changes out of any Advanced Placement class will not be allowed until after the first quarter at minimum. Students will also need to meet all the expectations of the Advanced Placement classes, including completing summer work, participating in classes, and seeking extra help if there are issues.
